we mark the one-year anniversary of the war in Ukraine, please honor Ukraine's bravery and commitment to democracy for the people of the free world. Continue to keep Ukraine in your thoughts and prayers as they stand strong against Russian aggression. AFSCME's belief in human rights, wherever in the world they may be threatened, demands that we do what we can. At last year's General Assembly, HGEA delegates voted to adopt a resolution to declare February 24 as "Remember Ukraine Day." If you are in a place

to give, please consider contributing to one of the international relief organizations providing humanitarian aid to Ukraine.

Chapters have started to schedule more in-person meetings for outreach, chapter business, and community activities.
